FTTR Overview

Fiber to the Room (FTTR) extends fiber optic connectivity from the building entrance to every individual room, unlike FTTH, which terminates fiber at the dwelling entrance, or FTTB, which relies on in-building copper for the last segment . In Austria, FTTR is increasingly relevant due to the EU Gigabit Infrastructure Regulation, mandating fiber-capable building networks in new constructions from February 2026 . FTTR uses single-mode fibers with LC-APC connectors, passive optical splitters, and sub-ONUs in each room to ensure uninterrupted gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds .

800mm Depth Panels

An 800mm depth panel refers to the physical installation depth of the FTTR distribution panel, typically located in a central technical room or basement. These panels house optical splitters and fiber terminations, allowing organized distribution to multiple rooms. The depth ensures sufficient space for modular splice systems, bend radius compliance, and future expansion . Properly installed, these panels maintain signal attenuation below 0.4 dB per kilometer, even over distances exceeding 100 meters, ensuring consistent performance .
