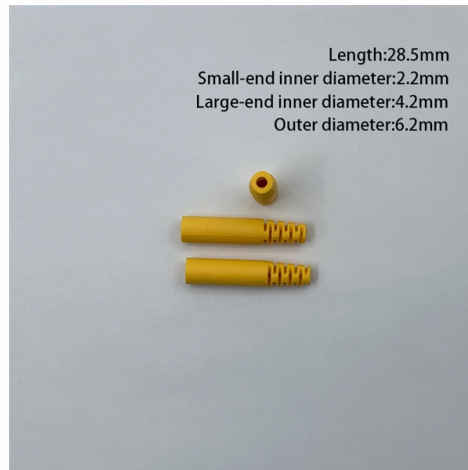


Blue switch in the distribution box is turned down



Overview

Turn off the power to the box at your breaker. Scrutinize Connection Quality. If you experience a sudden loss of power in a specific area of your home, follow these steps:

Identify the Tripped Breaker: Open the panel door and look for any breakers in the “off” position.

Turn Off Appliances: Before resetting the breaker. Each switch relates to a circuit (for example of lights or sockets) or individual appliances (for example an oven or electric shower). Usually there will be labels on the switches indicating which circuit or appliance the switch relates to. You will want a voltage tester (doesn't need to be a voltmeter) for this job. The very cheapest one you can find at a local hardware store (or online) will work great. They tell you if electricity is flowing through the.
