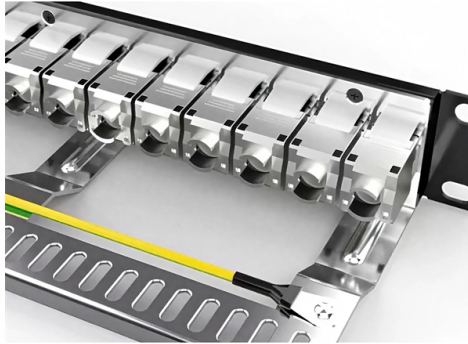


Cable tray support painting quota



Article Overview

Cable tray painting quotas depend on tray material, coating type, surface preparation, and project scope, with typical industrial coatings ranging from 60–80 microns thickness for durability and corrosion protection.

Factors Affecting Painting Quota

- **Material of Cable Tray** Cable trays are commonly made of galvanized steel, stainless steel, or mild steel. The type of steel affects the painting process and the amount of paint required. Galvanized steel often requires surface degreasing and phosphating before painting to ensure proper adhesion and corrosion resistance .
- **Type of Coating**
 - **Epoxy-Polyester Hybrid Resin:** Applied as powder coating, polymerized at 185–190°C for 15 minutes, with a coating thickness of 60–80 microns, providing excellent adherence and protection in humid or mild chemical environments .
 - **Polyester Resin Coating:** Applied similarly with polymerization at 190–195°C, resistant to UV, humidity, aggressive chemicals, and saline environments, also with 60–80 microns thickness .
- **Water-Based Paints:** Suitable for cable sheaths and trays where LSOH cables are present, avoiding oil-based paints that can degrade PVC or LSOH materials .
- **Surface Preparation** Proper preparation includes degreasing, phosphating, and sometimes sandblasting to remove contaminants and improve paint adhesion. This step is critical for achieving the desired coating thickness and durability .
- **Project Scope and Coverage** The painting quota is influenced by:
 - Total length and width of cable trays
