

Connect the optical port of one switch to the optical port of another switch



Article Overview

To connect the optical port of a switch to another switch, use compatible SFP/SFP+ transceivers with clean duplex fiber cables, ensuring proper insertion and port configuration for reliable data transmission.

Required Components

- **SFP/SFP+ Modules:** These transceivers connect the switch to fiber optic cables. Choose modules compatible with your switch and the fiber type (single-mode for long distances, multi-mode for shorter distances) .
- **Fiber Optic Cables:** Use duplex cables with LC connectors. Ensure the send and receive strands are correctly crossed between switches (A to B, B to A) .
- **Optional Patch Panels:** For organized cable management and easier maintenance .
- **ESD Protection:** Wear a grounded wrist strap to prevent static damage when handling transceivers .

Step-by-Step Connection

- **Verify Compatibility:** Confirm the switch supports the SFP/SFP+ module type and speed, and that the fiber type matches the module specifications .
- **Clean Connectors:** Inspect and clean transceiver and fiber ends to remove dust or fingerprints, which can increase signal loss (attenuation should remain below 0.35 dB) .
