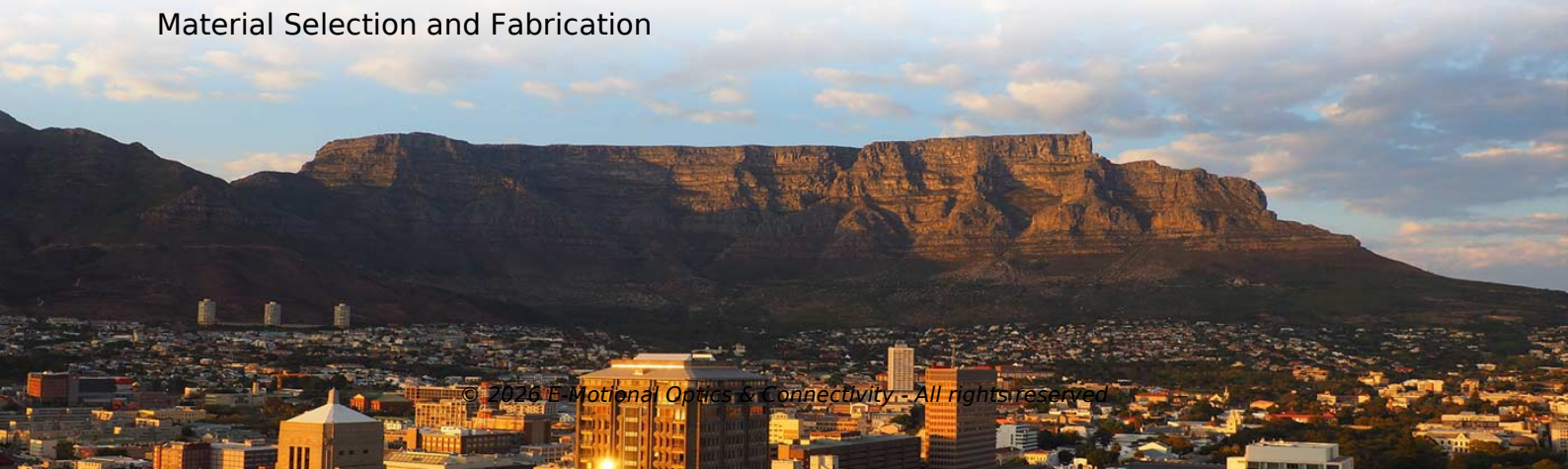
Requirement Analysis
