

# Distribution Box Terminal Block Planning

Effective planning of distribution box terminal blocks involves selecting the right block types, arranging them modularly, ensuring proper wiring, and documenting connections clearly.

### Types of Terminal Blocks

Distribution boxes typically use two main types of terminal blocks:

- **Distribution Blocks:** Designed for potential distribution, these blocks allow multiple connections from a single input and are modular, compact, and extendable. They often feature internal bridging and Push-in connections for efficient load and control current distribution (Phoenix Contact) .
- **Device Terminal Blocks:** Used for connecting electrical or electronic devices, these blocks handle separate potentials and are available in 2- to 5-position configurations. They are suitable for small junction boxes and grid connections (Phoenix Contact) .

### Planning and Configuration

- **Determine the Number of Connections:** Assess the number of circuits and devices to be connected. Distribution blocks can have up to 18 connections per block, and additional blocks can be linked via tongue-and-groove connections for potential extension (Phoenix Contact) .
- **Select Conductor Entry Type:** Choose between front Push-in or vertical/lateral connections depending on space and wiring convenience (Phoenix Contact) .
