Explosion-proof distribution boxes must meet strict design, material, certification, and installation standards to safely operate in hazardous environments.

Key Design and Safety Requirements

Explosion-proof distribution boxes are engineered to contain internal sparks or explosions and prevent ignition of surrounding flammable gases, vapors, or dusts . The design must consider:

- **Enclosure Type:** Flameproof (Ex d) or increased safety (Ex e) enclosures are commonly used, depending on the hazardous zone classification .
- **Material Selection:** Robust materials such as stainless steel (Baosteel 304 or higher), aluminum, or GRP are required for mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, and durability .
- **Wall Thickness:** Stainless steel enclosures should have a minimum thickness of 4.0 mm to withstand internal explosions .
- **Ingress Protection (IP) Rating:** Typically IP66 or higher to prevent dust and water ingress .
- **Temperature Class:** Must be compatible with the maximum surface temperature to avoid igniting surrounding atmospheres .
