

Exporting Fiber Optic Switch Configuration



Article Overview

You can export a fiber optic switch configuration using CLI commands, web-based utilities, or automated scripts via protocols like SCP, SFTP, FTP, or TFTP.

Using Web-Based or GUI Tools

Many switches provide a web interface for configuration management. To export a configuration:

- Log in to the switch's web-based utility using your administrator credentials.
- Navigate to Administration > File Management > File Operations or a similar menu.
- Select Backup File and choose the configuration type to export, such as Running Configuration, Startup Configuration, or Mirror Configuration.
- Choose the destination: USB drive, internal flash, TFTP/SFTP/SCP server, or your computer.
- Initiate the backup and monitor progress. Ensure the server host key is correctly set if using SCP/SFTP for secure transfer .

Using CLI Commands

For switches supporting CLI:

- Connect via SSH, Telnet, or console port.
- Use commands to copy the configuration to a remote host. For example:
- TFTP: `copy running-config tftp://`
