

Exposed fiber optic cable routing

Proper routing of exposed fiber optic cables requires careful planning, support, and protection to prevent signal loss, physical damage, and environmental degradation.

Planning and Design

Before routing exposed fiber, plan the path carefully. Identify the route, consider future expansion, and ensure minimal congestion. Use cable management components such as trays, guides, and ties to organize the cables and prevent tangling or sharp bends . Maintain separation from power cables to avoid electromagnetic interference and ensure safety . For outdoor runs, consider environmental factors like UV exposure, temperature fluctuations, and moisture .

Cable Support and Protection

Exposed fiber must be supported along its entire length. Use cable ties, clips, or trays to prevent sagging and reduce stress on the fiber core . Avoid sharp bends; maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to prevent microbending or macrobending losses . For outdoor installations, consider using UV-resistant jackets and protective boots to shield the fiber from sunlight and weather . Thermal cycling can cause expansion and contraction, potentially damaging connectors or the fiber itself .
