Overview

Prior to installing the Fiber Optic Repeaters, fiber optic cable must be installed. The repeaters have the following characteristics: Model 490NRP253 provides a Fiber Optic Point-to-Point link between two Modbus Plus. The RS 485 repeater amplifies data signals (amplitude, edge slope and signal width) on bus lines and couples segments.
