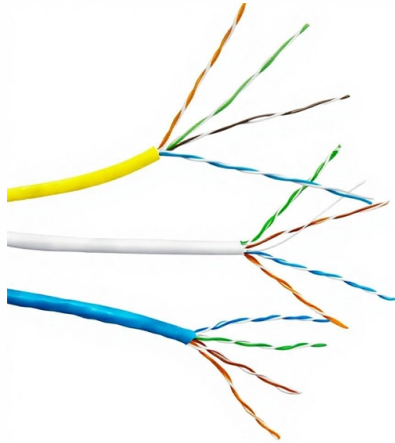


Fire-resistant galvanized steel cable trays are made of steel

Galvanized Steel Properties

Hot-dip galvanized steel trays are coated with zinc to protect against corrosion, making them effective in low-risk environments. However, zinc melts at relatively low temperatures, which means the protective coating can fail quickly during a fire, compromising both the tray and the cables it supports. While galvanized steel provides mechanical strength and corrosion resistance, it does not inherently prevent fire spread.

Better Alternatives for Fire Resistance

- Fire-coated steel trays: These are treated with a fire-resistant coating that forms an insulating layer during a fire, significantly reducing the risk of fire propagation. They are considered the top choice for high-risk environments such as data centers, hospitals, and high-rise buildings.
- Stainless steel trays: While stainless steel can withstand high temperatures without losing structural integrity, it does not prevent fire spread and is primarily used where corrosion resistance is the main concern.
- Aluminum trays: Aluminum has a low melting point and conducts heat efficiently, making it unsuitable for fire-sensitive environments.
