A distribution box (DB box) is an electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it to various outgoing circuits while providing protection against overloads, short circuits, and earth faults (). It is commonly used in residential, commercial, and industrial settings and serves as the central hub for electrical power management.

Key Components

- **Main Switch/Isolator:** Controls the entire power supply to the distribution box, allowing all circuits to be disconnected simultaneously for maintenance or emergencies ().
- **Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overload and short-circuit currents. Each outgoing circuit is connected to an MCB matched to the conductor size and load type ().
