

How high should the indoor electrical distribution box be

The recommended height for an indoor electrical distribution box is typically between 1.3 meters (4.3 feet) and 2 meters (6.5 feet) from the floor, ensuring accessibility and compliance with safety standards.

Recommended Mounting Height

For indoor wall-mounted distribution boxes, the ideal height is generally 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) from the floor, which allows easy access without bending or stretching excessively and protects the box from accidental impacts or water spills . For residential installations, standards such as BS 7671 and IEC 60364-5-52 suggest a height range of 1 meter to 1.8 meters, with 1.3 meters being suitable for elderly or handicapped users . The NEC 2023 specifies that the center of the operating handle of the highest circuit breaker should not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) above the floor .

Clearance and Accessibility

Electrical codes emphasize that distribution boxes must be readily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection. Adequate working space should be maintained in front of the panel, typically 3 feet (0.9 meters) deep and 30 inches (0.76 meters) wide, with no obstructions such as furniture, pipes, or shelving . This ensures safe operation and allows the panel door to open fully.
