

How many meters of cable should be reserved from the distribution box



Overview

The installation height of the distribution electrical box should be controlled at 1.5 meters, which is convenient for operation and maintenance. At least 1 meter of space should be reserved around the box to facilitate inspection, maintenance, and component replacement. You need to calculate and select the right number and spacing of cables when using junction boxes. This step keeps your project safe and.

Number of cables per box = cable length per box / actual average cable length

Number of cable boxes required = total number of information points / number of cables per box

Note: The horizontal distance of the farthest and nearest information points is the actual horizontal distance from the floor. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.5 meters).

Connector Space: Terminal points require extra length - don't short-change them! As any seasoned electrician will tell you: "Measure twice, cut once" isn't just a cute saying.
