

How to connect an ONU to an optical module switch



Article Overview

To connect an ONU to an optical module switch, you must use a GPON-compatible ONU module and connect it via fiber to the OLT or optical splitter, ensuring proper registration and optical power levels.

Hardware Requirements

- **ONU Device:** Ensure it has a GPON SFP module or built-in GPON port. Standard Ethernet SFPs are not compatible with GPON ports due to different physical and MAC layer protocols .
- **OLT or Optical Module Switch:** Must support GPON or the specific PON standard used.
- **Fiber Optic Cables:** SC/APC or SC/UPC patch cords, depending on the connectors.
- **Passive Optical Splitter:** If connecting multiple ONUs to a single OLT port.
- **Power Supply:** Typically 12V DC for the ONU.
- **Computer or Management Device:** For initial configuration via web interface, CLI, or SNMP.

Physical Connection Steps

- **Install Devices:** Mount the OLT in the central office or data center and the ONU at the customer premises or endpoint .
