Step-by-Step Procedure

1. Gather Tools and Equipment You will need a fiber optic patch panel, fiber optic cables, connectors (LC, SC, ST, MPO/MTP), fiber stripper, cleaver, epoxy or mechanical splice kit, polishing tools, a light source, and a power meter for testing signal integrity . 2. Prepare the Patch Panel Remove the protective cover from the patch panel and inspect the ports for dust or debris. Ensure the routing paths are clear and ready for cable installation . 3. Strip and Clean the Fiber Cable Use a fiber optic stripper to remove the outer jacket of the cable without damaging the inner fibers. Clean the exposed fibers with a lint-free cloth and cleave them to the correct length for connector installation . 4. Install the Connector Attach the connector to the fiber using one of the following methods:

- Epoxy and Polish: Apply epoxy, cure, and polish the fiber end.
- Mechanical Splice: Quick, adhesive-free method for temporary or rapid connections.
