The per-splice cost for fiber optic cables, including ribbon cables, generally ranges from \$50 to \$150 for fusion splicing, depending on project size, fiber count, site conditions, and contractor overhead. Ribbon cables, which bundle multiple fibers in a flat ribbon format, allow mass-fusion splicing, where each 12-fiber ribbon can be spliced in a single operation, reducing labor costs and installation time. For example, a 144-fiber ribbon cable could be spliced in 12 mass-fusion operations instead of 144 individual splices, lowering the effective per-fiber cost.

Factors Affecting Price

- **Fiber Count and Ribbon Design:** Higher fiber counts in ribbon cables reduce the per-fiber splice cost due to volume efficiency.
- **Site Conditions:** Aerial installations are generally cheaper than underground vault work, which may require traffic control or confined space entry.
- **Equipment and Labor:** Fusion splicers cost between \$3,000 and \$15,000, while cleavers range from \$500 to \$2,000. Skilled technicians are required for precise alignment and low-loss splicing. Mass-fusion splicing reduces the number of technician hours needed.
