Expand Fibre Channel Deployment

- Increase SAN Coverage: Connect more servers and storage arrays to your Fibre Channel fabric using Host Bus Adapters (HBAs) and Fibre Channel switches .
- Dual Fabrics for Redundancy: Implement Fabric A and Fabric B to ensure continuous access and failover, which encourages broader adoption across critical systems .
