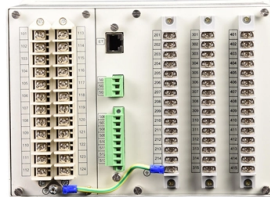


How to wire the surge protector switch in the distribution box

Use AWG #10 stranded wire or larger (which is readily available and easily installed) to connect between the SPD and the breaker panel. Short direct connections. Choose a DIN rail or wall-mounted location. Live wire to the breaker terminal (dedicated SPD. Drill and punch a hole in the SPD housing in a position to minimize the length of the connecting wires from the lugs of the SPD to the circuit breaker in the adjacent panel (or fused disconnect lugs).
