Selecting the right SFP optical module for data centers requires careful consideration of compatibility, data rate, distance, fiber type, wavelength, and thermal management to prevent celling and ensure reliable operation.

Key Selection Factors

1. Compatibility Ensure the SFP module is fully compatible with your switch, router, or server platform. Incompatibility can cause ports to remain down, trigger alarms, or generate error logs. Verify vendor compatibility or use OEM-certified modules to avoid rejection errors, especially in multi-vendor environments (Cisco, Juniper, Arista, HP) . 2. Data Rate Matching Select modules that match the network's required speed. Common SFP rates include 1G, 10G, 25G, and higher for QSFP-DD or OSFP modules. Auto-negotiation may not work across different rates, so manual speed matching is critical to prevent link failures . 3. Transmission Distance and Fiber Type

- Short-reach (SR): Up to 300m, typically multimode fiber (MMF) at 850nm.
- Long-reach (LR): 2-10km, single-mode fiber (SMF) at 1310nm.
