

Indoor Monitoring Distribution Box Configuration Requirements

Indoor distribution boxes must be installed securely, wired neatly, equipped with protective devices, and comply with safety standards to ensure reliable and safe power distribution.

Installation Requirements

Indoor distribution boxes should be installed in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters for easy maintenance and monitoring. The enclosure should be made of non-combustible materials such as steel or high-quality thermoplastics like polycarbonate or ASA, providing protection against dust, moisture, and physical damage. Flush-mounted covers should fit closely to the wall, and box openings must match conduit diameters to prevent gaps or exposure. Proper support and secure mounting are essential to prevent movement or vibration.

Wiring and Electrical Configuration

Wiring inside the box must be neat, untwisted, and properly insulated, with connections tight enough to avoid damaging wire cores. The cross-sectional area of wires should meet design specifications: typically no less than 2.5 mm² for current-carrying circuits and 1.5 mm² for other circuits. Circuits of different voltage levels, AC/DC lines, and control lines should be bundled separately and clearly identified to prevent interference and simplify maintenance. No more than two wires should connect to a single terminal, and anti-loosening washers should be used to secure connections.
