

Installation Standards for Wall-Mounted Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Wall-mounted distribution boxes should be installed at accessible heights, in dry and ventilated locations, with proper IP/NEMA ratings, secure mounting, and compliant wiring to ensure safety and reliability.

Mounting Height and Accessibility

For indoor installations, the recommended height is 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) from the floor, making the box easily reachable without bending or stretching excessively, while protecting it from accidental impacts or water spills . Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet above ground to avoid water and dirt exposure . In industrial settings, consider placing boxes higher to stay clear of machinery or high-traffic areas.

Enclosure Selection and Ratings

Choose the enclosure based on the environment and load requirements. IP or NEMA ratings indicate protection against dust, water, and corrosive atmospheres. For outdoor or washdown locations, IP66, IP67, or IP69K ratings are recommended . Material selection is also important: steel is durable for harsh environments, while plastic is suitable for indoor use . UV-resistant and rust-proof coatings are essential for outdoor installations.
