GJXV is a type of single-mode optical fiber cable designed for outdoor aerial installations, offering high tensile strength and protection against environmental stress.

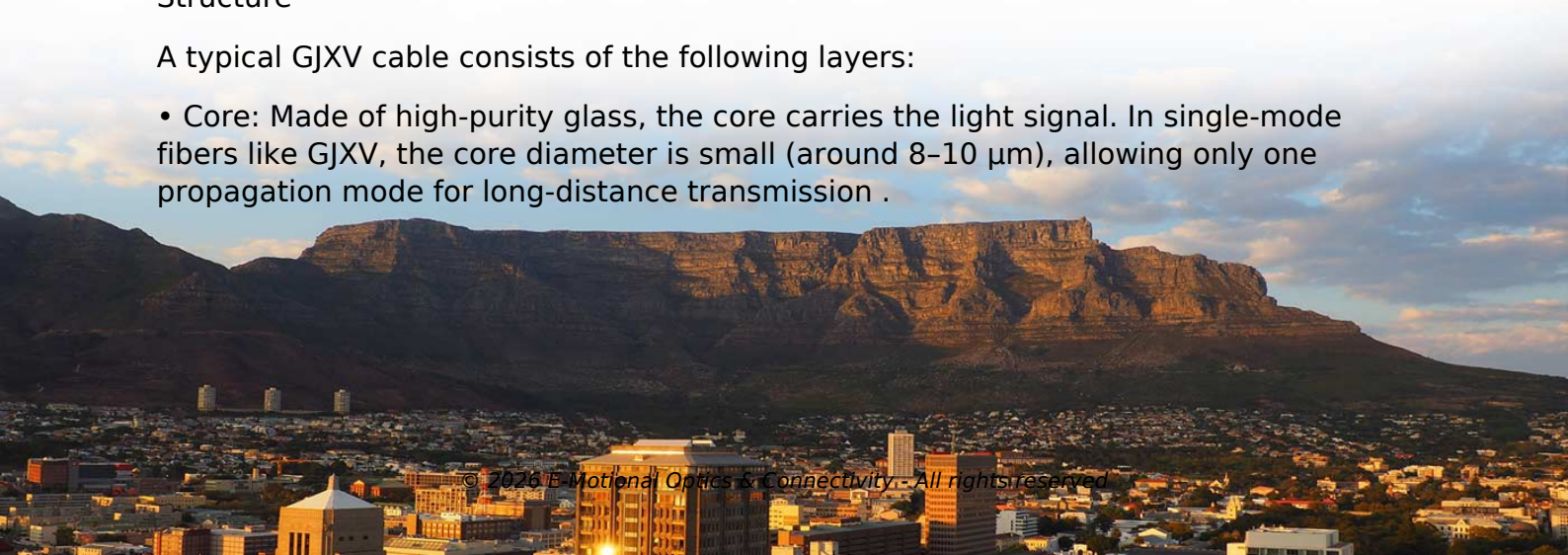
Overview

GJXV cables are single-mode optical fiber cables commonly used in aerial deployments along poles or overhead lines. They are designed to transmit light signals over long distances with minimal loss, leveraging the principle of total internal reflection to confine light within the fiber core, ensuring high-speed and high-bandwidth communication .

Structure

A typical GJXV cable consists of the following layers:

- Core: Made of high-purity glass, the core carries the light signal. In single-mode fibers like GJXV, the core diameter is small (around 8-10 μm), allowing only one propagation mode for long-distance transmission .
