Quick answers: A cable tray is an open, rigid support system used to route and organise electrical cables in buildings and industrial facilities — replacing conduit in most large-scale installations. The three main types are ladder tray, perforated (solid-bottom) tray, and wire. As with anything electrical, the National Electrical Code (NEC) has rules tied to its use. 2 defines a cable tray system as “a unit or assembly of units or sections with associated fittings forming a rigid structural system used to securely fasten or support cables and raceways.
