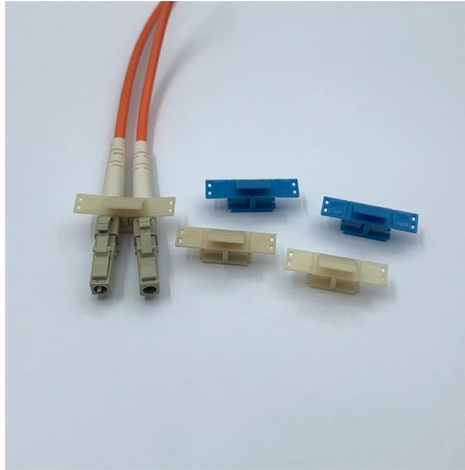


Latest Network Cabinet Classification Table



Overview

Network cabinets come in several main types: wall-mount (compact, for small spaces), floor-standing (most common, various depths and heights), outdoor (weatherproof, for harsh environments), acoustic (noise-reducing), and specialized (e., seismic, co-location), each. Each type of enclosure is given a number based on its ability to withstand environmental factors. There are two main standards: NEMA (National Electrical Manufacturers Association) in the U.
