

Laying of Figure-8 Optical Cables

Figure-8 optical cable installation prevents twisting and kinking, ensuring safe and efficient deployment for aerial and ground applications.

What is Figure-8 Cable?

Figure-8 optical cable, also called self-supporting figure-8 cable, combines optical fibers with an integrated messenger wire in a distinctive “8” cross-section. This design allows the cable to be suspended between poles without additional support hardware, making it ideal for aerial deployments, rural broadband, urban pole-to-home drops, 5G backhaul, and utility co-deployment projects (). The cable consists of two main components:

- Messenger component: a steel strand providing structural support
- Cable component: the optical fiber core within a protective jacket This integration simplifies installation, reduces labor, and enhances durability ().

Figure-8 Installation on the Ground

When pulling cable from a reel or conduit, the figure-8 loop technique prevents twisting:

- Lay the cable on the ground in a large figure-8 pattern, typically 6-12 feet (2-4 meters) per loop depending on cable stiffness ().
- Use a tarp or plastic sheet to keep the cable clean.
- Pull slowly, carefully forming the figure-8 to avoid kinks.
- For a standard pull, pick up the cable and flip it so the end to be pulled is on top.
