Article Overview

In a data center basement, power distribution boxes (PDUs and switchboards) are typically located downstream of the UPS and transformers, forming a structured layout that delivers power to IT racks and facility loads.

Overview of Basement Power Distribution Layout

In a standard data center, the basement houses the primary electrical distribution equipment, including:

- Medium Voltage (MV) or High Voltage (HV) Transformers: Step down utility voltage to low voltage suitable for IT and facility loads .
- Low-Voltage Switchboards: Serve as the main distribution point, routing power to downstream circuits and providing overcurrent protection .
- Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Systems: Positioned near the switchboards to condition power and provide backup during outages .
- Power Distribution Units (PDUs) and Remote Power Panels (RPPs): Located downstream of the UPS, these boxes step down voltage further (e.g., from 480V to 208V or 120V) and distribute power to server racks and other equipment .

Typical Power Flow in the Basement

- Utility Feed Entry: Power enters the basement from the utility grid, often through a dedicated MV/HV service .
- Transformers: Medium voltage is stepped down to low voltage for safe distribution .
