- 10G (10GBASE-T): Cat6 can carry 10 Gbps, but only over shorter distances, typically 37–55 meters, depending on cable quality, installation, and electromagnetic interference . For full 100-meter 10G support, Cat6A is recommended.

Factors Affecting Performance

- Cable Quality: Higher-quality Cat6 cables with proper twist rates, solid copper conductors (23AWG or 24AWG), and good insulation reduce crosstalk and signal loss .
- Installation: Proper termination, avoiding sharp bends, and minimizing interference from electrical sources are critical for maintaining speed .
- Hardware Compatibility: Network devices must support the desired speed. If a Cat6 link negotiates at 100 Mbps, it usually indicates a device limitation, not a cable limitation .
- Shielding: Standard unshielded Cat6 is sufficient for most office environments, but shielded variants (F/UTP, SF/UTP) are recommended in high-EMI areas .
