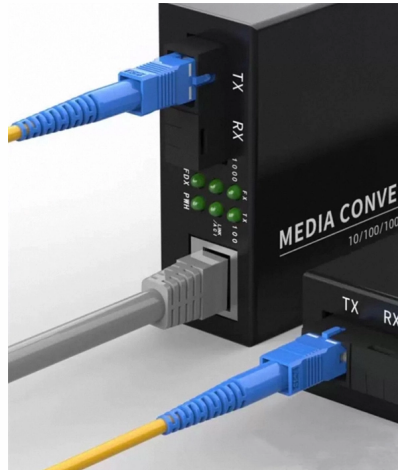

Co-packaged optics (CPO) puts the optical engine — the part that converts electrical signals into light — directly onto the switch chip's own package, instead of in a removable transceiver on the front panel. The fiber connects right at the chip. Unlike traditional pluggable optical.
