Overview of Fiber Optic Connectors

Fiber optic connectors are mechanical devices that align and join optical fibers, allowing light to pass with minimal loss while enabling easy connection and disconnection for maintenance or network reconfiguration. Common connector types include SC, LC, ST, FC, MPO/MTP, and specialized power or hybrid connectors. LC connectors are widely used in high-density applications due to their 1.25mm ferrule and compact latch mechanism, while SC/APC connectors are preferred where low return loss is critical, such as RF video or GPON networks. High-performance connectors, such as those from Molex and Amphenol, support multi-fiber configurations (16, 24, or even 144 fibers) and are designed for data centers, telecom, and industrial applications, including 100G and 400G transceivers. These connectors often feature push-pull boots, ultra-bend insensitive fibers, and EMI shielding to improve reliability and simplify installation in dense environments.
