Key SD-WAN Device Types for Remote Monitoring

- **WAN Edge Routers (Physical and Virtual)** These devices form the core of SD-WAN deployments, connecting branches, data centers, and cloud environments. They can be physical appliances or virtual instances deployed in cloud or on-premises environments. Remote monitoring focuses on metrics such as bandwidth utilization, latency, jitter, packet loss, CPU/memory usage, and SLA compliance (Cisco Catalyst SD-WAN) .
- **Enterprise Agents** Deployed at campuses, branch offices, or virtual networks, these agents monitor underlay and overlay performance, policy routing, and connectivity to SaaS or internal applications. They provide granular visibility into network paths and end-user experience, enabling proactive troubleshooting and optimization .
- **Cloud Agents** Pre-deployed in major cloud provider data centers and connected to Tier 1-3 ISPs, cloud agents allow monitoring of Internet reachability, SaaS application performance, and ISP comparison. They are essential for hybrid WAN architectures where direct Internet access is used alongside MPLS or VPN tunnels .
