

Should the gigabit fiber optic port be connected to the router

Yes, a gigabit fiber optic port can be used to connect a router, but it typically requires either an SFP module or an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal to Ethernet.

Connecting via an ONT

Most residential fiber internet setups use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP. The ONT converts the fiber-optic light signal into a standard Ethernet signal, which can then be connected to your router's Gigabit Ethernet WAN port using a Cat5e or Cat6 cable. You cannot plug a fiber cable directly into a standard router because the router's Ethernet ports only handle electrical signals over copper, not optical signals. Once connected, your router manages your home network, Wi-Fi, and device connections.

Using an SFP Port

Some routers and switches feature SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) ports, which allow direct fiber connections via compatible SFP modules. These modules act as transceivers, converting optical signals to electrical signals that the router can process. You must ensure the SFP module matches your ISP's fiber type and supports Gigabit speeds. Once installed, the SFP port functions similarly to a WAN port, and no additional configuration is usually required.
