

Standard height of outdoor distribution boxes above ground



Article Overview

Outdoor distribution boxes should generally be installed at least 3 feet (36 inches) above ground, with a typical ergonomic height around 4.5 to 5.5 feet for accessibility and safety.

Recommended Height

For outdoor installations, the minimum height is typically 3 feet (36 inches) above the ground to protect the box from water, dirt, and debris, while ensuring it remains accessible for maintenance. Wall-mounted boxes are often installed between 4.5 and 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) to allow easy reach without bending or stretching excessively. In residential settings, a height of 3 to 6 feet is common, with around 4 feet being suitable for older or disabled users.

Code and Safety Considerations

- NEC Article 312 requires outdoor distribution boxes in wet locations to have rain-tight enclosures and proper clearance for safe operation.
- The front edge of the box should be flush with the finished surface, typically not more than 6 mm (1/4 inch) recessed.
- Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly elevated (2-4 inches) to prevent moisture damage.
- All outdoor boxes should be GFCI-protected and rated for weather resistance, especially in areas prone to flooding or heavy snow.
