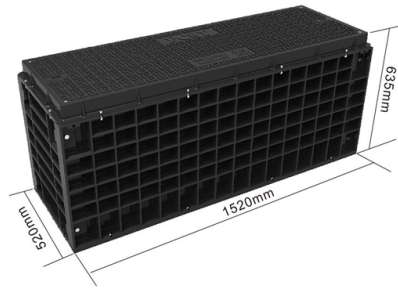

Switches use Ethernet ports for copper connections and fiber optic ports for long-distance, high-speed transmission, with electrical ports referring to the physical interfaces for copper-based Ethernet.

Ethernet Ports

Ethernet ports are the most common switch interfaces, typically using RJ45 connectors for copper cables. They support speeds from 10 Mbps to 10 Gbps, depending on the cable type (Cat5, Cat6, or Cat6A) and switch capabilities. Ethernet ports are ideal for access-layer connections, connecting computers, printers, and other devices within a local area network (LAN). They are limited to short distances, usually up to 100 meters for copper cabling. Some Ethernet ports also support Power over Ethernet (PoE) to power devices like IP cameras or phones.

Fiber Optic Ports

Fiber optic ports use optical modules to transmit data via fiber optic cables, enabling high-speed and long-distance communication. Common speeds include 1.25G, 10G, 25G, 40G, and 100G, with transmission distances ranging from hundreds of meters to over 100 kilometers, depending on the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and module. Fiber ports are often used for uplinks between switches, data center interconnects, or connecting remote locations. Many switches support SFP/SFP+ modules, allowing flexible conversion between fiber and Ethernet media.
