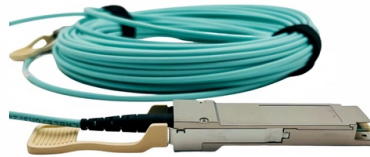


Terminal Distribution Box Circuit Identification

Understanding the Distribution Box

A distribution box is an enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it to multiple outgoing circuits through protective devices such as MCBs, RCCBs, RCBOs, fuses, and busbars . Each outgoing circuit is connected to a terminal or breaker, which protects the circuit from overloads and short circuits. The box also contains a neutral bar and an earth bar for proper grounding and safety .

Circuit Numbering and Labeling

Proper circuit identification ensures safe maintenance and troubleshooting. Circuits are typically numbered and labeled according to standards, which may vary by region but generally follow these principles :

- Sequential numbering: Each outgoing circuit is assigned a unique number, often starting from the top-left breaker and proceeding row by row.
- Functional labeling: Labels indicate the load or area served, e.g., "Kitchen Lights," "AC Unit," or "Socket Outlet 1."
- RCD/RCCB grouping: Circuits protected by the same residual-current device are grouped and labeled accordingly to indicate which circuits will trip together.
