Cable trays with a hollow or perforated bottom are designed to improve ventilation, reduce weight, and allow drainage while supporting cables safely.

Purpose of a Hollow Bottom

A hollow or ventilated bottom in a cable tray serves several key functions:

- **Ventilation and Heat Dissipation:** Hollow bottoms allow air to circulate around the cables, which helps dissipate heat generated by electrical currents. This is particularly important for power cables or densely packed installations, as solid-bottom trays can trap heat and increase the risk of overheating .
- **Weight Reduction:** By removing material from the bottom, the tray becomes lighter, making it easier to handle, transport, and install without compromising structural integrity .
- **Drainage:** Hollow or perforated bottoms allow water or other liquids to drain away, preventing moisture accumulation that could damage cables or cause corrosion, especially in outdoor or humid environments .
- **Cable Access and Flexibility:** Small instrumentation or control cables can sometimes exit through the perforations, providing flexibility in routing and reducing the need for additional support accessories .
