What Causes a Network Switch Failure?

A switch failure can result from several issues, including: Power Supply Issues – Switch not powering on or experiencing power. A network switch is a device that connects multiple devices on a Local Area Network (LAN) and directs data traffic between them. It acts as a central hub, ensuring that data packets are delivered accurately and quickly to their intended recipients. Their failures may originate from physical layer connection anomalies or may be caused by logical configuration and hardware. Switches are the silent workhorses of modern networks —routing traffic, connecting endpoints, and managing Layer 2 forwarding with speed and precision.
