Primary distribution voltages range from 4 kV to 35 kV phase-to-phase (2. 4 kV to 20 kV phase-to-neutral) Only large consumers are fed directly from distribution voltages; most utility customers are connected to a transformer, which reduces the distribution voltage to the low. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. For technical and economic reasons, the service voltage of medium voltage distribution networks rarely exceeds 36 kV. The connection of an.
