Select Grounding Conductor: Choose a grounding conductor of adequate size based on the amperage of the branch circuit feeding the rack and. For internal cabinet grounding, when dispensing liquids inside a safety cabinet, as shown in picture at left, it is important to ensure good electrical continuity through metal-to-metal contact when attaching

Signal integrity grounding

Check regulations in your location, but the main reason for grounding is electrical safety not signal interference. A rack/cabinet is likely to have multiple powered devices and lots of metal

How & Why to Ground Wiring

Install grounding wire to provide current with alternate paths to avoid electrical shocks in case of power surges. Run ground wires parallel to hot and neutral wires in a branch circuit.

Application Note

Connections of SBB to the PBB should be made with an appropriate-size, UL listed, two-hole crimp style lug and appropriate gauge cable. The PBB should be bonded via Telecommunications Bonding
