- **Poor fiber management:** Overcrowding fibers, tangling, or inadequate labeling can make maintenance difficult and increase the risk of accidental fiber damage.
- **Material degradation:** UV radiation, extreme heat, or cold can make plastic components brittle, potentially compromising the box or connectors inside.
